Player and Coach Code of Conduct

All parties agree that participation in Florida Youth Basketball Association (FYBA) is a privilege and not a right. FYBA reserves the right to revoke the privilege of any player, parent, coach, official, spectator or participant to attend any FYBA function, practice or game at any time. If a game official, a Division Director, Coach, or FYBA Board Member should ask me to leave a function of FYBA, I agree to comply immediately without discussion.

FYBA expects all players, parents, and spectators to act with good sportsmanship at all times in connection with FYBA functions. FYBA also expects all players, parents and spectators to respect the gymnasiums and our school hosts by not bringing any food or drink, except for water for players, into the gyms at any time during a FYBA function. Parents, players and spectators agree that they will never try to distract any referee, player, or opposing team member during a game or engage in any verbal or physical abuse or unsportsmanlike conduct of any kind.

I/We agree that failure to comply with FYBA rules of play (High School basketball rules with FYBA enhancements) or FYBA rules of conduct as described herein may result in the administration of technical fouls against me or my team or my coach, and that consequently I may be ejected from games, or the FYBA temporarily or permanently at the discretion of FYBA. I/We agree that if I am ejected or suspended, my privileges with respect to FYBA have been revoked and I may no longer attend FYBA functions in any capacity until notified of the lifting of the suspension by FYBA and its representatives. I/We agree that if suspended from FYBA, I/We are not entitled to a refund of monies paid.

A copy of FYBA rules is available from any FYBA official upon request.

I/We have read this agreement and agree to abide by the rules of FYBA and any disciplinary decision made by FYBA. I/We further understand that our signatures on the FYBA Roster or Coach Agreement form indicate our willingness to comply with its terms during this and any other subsequent season in which I/We participate in the FYBA. The signature of one parent on the FYBA Player Roster constitutes the express written acceptance of this Code of Conduct on behalf of all family members and friends who may attend FYBA games or practices.
